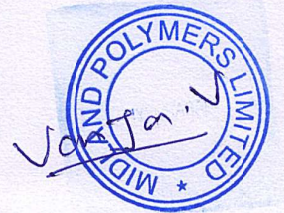

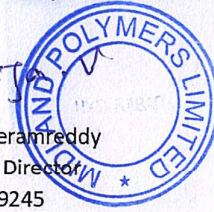

Report on the Audit of Financial Results

Opinion

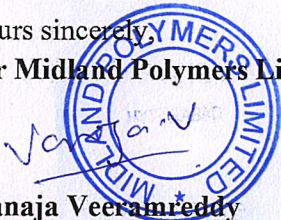
